

CUC 2007 Regional Allocations - Input From Teams Requested

Representatives of touring teams are requested to immediately advise CUPA of their team's interest in competing at CUC 2007 which is to be held in Toronto August 9 – 12.

CUPA's Tournament Manual provides for a total of 60 teams in 5 CUC divisions. However, the CUC 2007 facilities in Toronto can easily accommodate more than 60 teams. As the number of bids available for certain divisions may be insufficient to satisfy regional demand this year, CUPA is considering increasing the size of certain divisions.

In order that decisions can be made sufficiently early to accommodate planning by teams, players and the CUC 2007 organizers, CUPA requests the input of touring team's representatives **by Wednesday, April 25, 2007**.
